



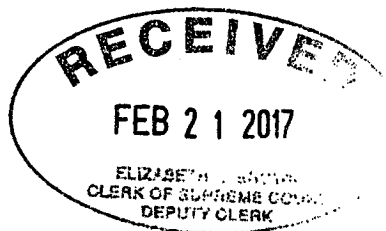
TO: The Honorable Supreme Court of the State of Nevada
