NOTICE OF RULE CHANGE

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th day of August, 2000, the Supreme Court of Nevada entered an order in ADKT No. 244 amending the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure. The order amends Nevada Rule of Appellate Procedure 16 governing settlement conferences in civil cases. Specifically, the order amends NRAP 16(a) to provide a method for removing a case from the settlement conference program, and amends NRAP 16(i) to prohibit settlement judges from using their status as Nevada Supreme Court settlement judges for advertising purposes. The amendment is effective October 17, 2000.

Rule changes are published by the Supreme Court Clerk in the same manner as an opinion of the court. In accordance with the Nevada Rules on the Administrative Docket, Section 6, the Clerk will disseminate printed copies of the order without charge to all subscribers to the advance opinions of the Nevada Reports. Single, printed copies of the order are available from the Supreme Court Clerk for \$2.00 each. Photocopies are available for \$.50 per page.
