

NOTICE OF RULE CHANGE

Notice is hereby given that on July 26, 2002, the Supreme Court of Nevada entered an order in ADKT No. 244 amending the Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure. The order amends Rule 16 relating to settlement conferences in civil appeals by repealing subsection(i) prohibiting settlement judges from advertising their status as a Nevada Supreme Court settlement judge. The amendment shall become effective on September 24, 2002.

Rule changes are published by the Supreme Court Clerk in the same manner as an opinion of the court. In accordance with the Nevada Rules on the Administrative Docket, Section 6, the Clerk will disseminate printed copies of the order without charge to all subscribers to the advance opinions of the Nevada Reports.
