NOTICE AND COMMENTS

NOTICE - WE ARE THE CLASS THAT RECEIVED FAVORABLE JUDGMENT IN THE NINTH CIRCUIT AGAINST GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WHO COMMIT MALPRACTICE BY RELYING UPON UNVERIFIED INTERNAL INFORMATION. WE DO INTEND TO ACQUIRE YOUR PUBLIC, PRIVATE, AND PERSONAL ASSETS AS AWARDED IN THE SEPTEMBER 2009 PUBLISHED RULING.

HERE COME NOW PETITIONERS desiring to compel this Honorable Court to consider all oral testimony and all filings regarding Evidence Retention and Destruction. We wish to move this Court to immediate action because the wrongful deaths of children under Clark County jurisdiction has increased 200% since January 2009.

September 2009, Las Vegas Sun reported court records are stacked on the Regional Justice Centers fourth floor. Eighth Judiciary Court Administrators Charles Short, Ed Friedland, and Steve Grierson admit the files are not accessible electronically by the judges. The files are documentation of children's abuse and neglect.

PETITIONERS are protesting weekly outside Family Division Courthouse and Child Protective Services in Las Vegas, Nevada. Child Protective Services recently fired two investigators for falsifying documents resulting in the wrongful deaths of children.
