7 COMES NOW, John McCormick, primary staff to the Indigent Defense
8 Commission (Commission), and requests this Honorable Court grant the
9 Commission an extension of 180 days from the deadline for submission of
10 recommendations concerning the collection of caseload statistics for assigned
11 or appointed indigent defense counsel as established in the Court's Order in
12 ADKT 411 date February 15, 2011.

13 The Commission met on March 11, 2011, to discuss this matter and was
14 unable to reach consensus or agreement on a plan to collect such data. Due
15 to the 2011 Nevada Legislative Session, as well as, the numerous personnel
16 and administrative changes in the Courts' Administrative Office, the
17 Commission has been unable to meet again to continue to work on such a plan.

18 Accordingly, an extension of 180 days from the original deadline
19 established in this Court's order of February 15, 2011, is hereby requested
20 to allow the Commission to meet and develop a plan for data collection.
