

Commission (Commission), and requests this Honorable Court grant the

Commission an extension of 180 days from the deadline for submission of

recommendations concerning the collection of caseload statistics for assigned

or appointed indigent defense counsel as established in the Court's Order in

ADKT 411 date February 15, 2011.

The Commission met on March 11, 2011, to discuss this matter and was unable to reach consensus or agreement on a plan to collect such data. Due to the 2011 Nevada Legislative Session, as well as, the numerous personnel and administrative changes in the Courts' Administrative Office, the Commission has been unable to meet again to continue to work on such a plan.

Accordingly, an extension of 180 days from the original deadline established in this Court's order of February 15, 2011, is hereby requested to allow the Commission to meet and develop a plan for data collection.
