2 **2008, AND THE NOVEMBER 20, 2007 STUDY WHICH RESULTED IN THE**

9 **WHEREAS**, on or about April 26, 2007, the Nevada Supreme Court (herein "The
10 Court") established a committee known as the Indigent Defense Commission
11 (herein "The Commission"), and
12

13 **WHEREAS**, The Nevada Supreme Court directed the Commission to conduct
14 hearings to "study the issues and concerns with respect to the selection,
15 appointment, compensation, and qualifications of counsel assigned to represent
16 indigent defendants in criminal and juvenile delinquency cases throughout
17 Nevada.", and
18

19 **WHEREAS**, The Supreme Court also directed the Commission to "recommend
20 appropriate changes for the Court's consideration", and
21

22 **WHEREAS**, on November 20, 2007, the Commission filed its "Final Report
23 and Recommendations of Supreme Court Indigent Defense Commission"
24 (herein the "Report"), attached hereto as Exhibit A, and
25

26 **WHEREAS**, on January 4, 2008, this Court issued an Order (herein "Order"),
27 attached hereto as Exhibit B, in the above-entitled matter, implementing several of
28 the recommendations from the Report including "Indigent Criminal Defense
29 Performance Standards" (herein "Performance Standards"), and
30

31 **WHEREAS**, the Humboldt County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") agrees
32 with the Court that appointment of counsel for indigent people is essential to the
33 system of justice that we have, and
34

35 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has taken steps in the past to take care
36 of the appointment of counsel for the indigent in criminal and juvenile cases, as
37 well as in Guardianships and Child Protection cases, and
38

39 **WHEREAS**, the Report has numerous inaccuracies regarding the services offered
40 in Humboldt County to indigent persons, including, but not limited to, the following:

41 a. The Report indicates that Pershing County has contracted with
42 a private law firm to provide indigent defense. See Report pg. 18 ("While
43 Pershing County was utilizing the State Public Defender, the relationship was
44 severed effective June 30, 2007. **A contract has since been awarded to a law
45 office.**" (Emphasis added). This is entirely inaccurate. The Report also
46 incorrectly states that Humboldt County is currently utilizing the State Public
47 Defender's Office. In accordance with NRS 260.010, the Board established
48 pursuant to ordinance 4-23-07, Chapter 2.44 of the Humboldt County Code, the
49 Office of County Public Defender. Additionally pursuant to NRS 260.010,
50 Humboldt and Pershing Counties have entered into a joint agreement, entitled
"Interlocal Agreement Creating the Joint Office of the Humboldt/Pershing Public

1 Defender." Furthermore, the local courts have a list of fully qualified Conflict
2 Public Defenders. Even when the Board contracted with the State Public
3 Defender, the services of a contract "Conflict Public Defender" were used.

4 b. The Report indicates that other than Elko, Washoe and Clark
5 Counties that have county public defender's offices, the rural counties should be
6 under the State Public Defender's Office. See Report pg 11, 12 and 69.
7 Humboldt County has a county public defender's office. Furthermore, the Board
8 believes that local control is superior to State control. While the Board would
9 support full State funding of indigent defense, the Board would prefer a block grant
10 allowing the Board to spend the money locally. The problem with State Agencies
11 is notorious in the smaller communities. When costs have to be cut, the smaller
12 rural counties always suffer disproportionately. While rising costs was a problem
13 with the State Public Defender that lead to the formation of an Office of the County
14 Public Defender, a larger and superceding problem was ensuring quality
15 representation by a State Agency over which the State Public Defender in Carson
16 had little supervisory capability. In 2005, the Humboldt and Pershing Counties had
17 considered going with a County Public Defender's Office but failed to have
18 sufficient time to implement such a determination.

19 c. Humboldt County has set forth a definition of indigent as
20 follows: "Means any person (or in a Juvenile Matter, a child's parent or guardian),
21 who is not able, financially, to secure the services of legal counsel by means of his
22 present or reasonably-anticipated resources, considering the seriousness, need,
23 and urgency of the matter, the difficulties or intricacies of the issues involved, and
24 the financial circumstances of the applicant." Humboldt County considers both
25 income and assets and confers with the Federal Poverty Guidelines ("FPG") as a
26 baseline. Using the FPG, the courts may appoint counsel even when the
27 applicant makes more than 300 percent of the FPG provided that they are
28 assessed a reasonable fee for counsel's services, and

29 **WHEREAS**, the order directing the District to implement changes which remove
30 the judges from the decision making process is not necessary and constitutes an
31 un-funded mandate. The report seems to indicate that a commission would be
32 necessary consisting of a three-person panel with diverse backgrounds in the
33 community. Because the appointment process would have to be ready to provide
34 a decision on a daily basis, such an appointment would require, at the minimum
35 three full-time persons. The cost of hiring three full-time people has not been
36 budgeted and would cause Humboldt County to violate procedures for budgeting
37 for the fiscal year, and

38 **WHEREAS**, based upon numbers provided by the Humboldt County Clerk, one
39 hundred fourteen (114) indigent defendants were provided services during FY 07.
40 Seventy-five percent of those cases were handled by the county public defender's
41 office while the remaining twenty-five percent were handled by conflict public
42 defenders paid on an hourly at \$100 an hour per NRS 7.125 and,

43 **WHEREAS**, a case was defined consistent with NRS 7.125 as a criminal
44 complaint or juvenile petition, even if more than one count was alleged in the
45 complaint, and

46 **WHEREAS**, the Order directing the District to exclude trial judges/justices of the
