WHEREAS, on December 18, 2008, this court adopted uniform rules to govern telephonic and audiovisual participation in Nevada courts, and

WHEREAS, the rules adopted require that participation by telephone or videoconference be allowed in certain cases, accordingly

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED every court of general jurisdiction and limited jurisdiction in the State of Nevada shall have equipment in place to allow for telephonic and/or audiovisual participation by September 30, 2009.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each general jurisdiction and limited jurisdiction judge shall file a report with the clerk of this court on or before September 1, 2009, informing this court

of the arrangements and/or equipment that has been installed to ensure compliance with the requirements of this order.
