
As background information, the Yerington Municipal Court has a very limited caseload, with average total filings of between 15 and 20 per month, including both criminal and traffic cases. Attorneys only appear one day each month. This being said, I am sure that our telephone conferencing system, commonly known as a "turtle", is an adequate answer to what the Supreme Court is trying to accomplish. If a necessity should arise where the defense attorney and the defendant need to speak privately, we have the time and the ability to recess court and all of the necessary parties may have the whole room in which to conference.

Hopefully, this will meet with the approval of the Nevada Supreme Court.
