REPORT

Pursuant to the Order of the Nevada Supreme Court dated July 30, 2009, the Canal Township Justice Court located in the City of Fernley, County of Lyon, State of Nevada reports as follows:

1. Telephonic conferencing. The Canal Township Justice Court has telephonic conferencing ability and telephonic conferencing is used from time to time as requested and/or to expedite proceedings. Said ability has been used for in excess of 10 years at the court's discretion.
2. Audiovisual. The Canal Township Justice Court has the present ability to conduct audiovisual proceedings between the Lyon County Jail which is located in Yerington, Nevada, being approximately fifty (50) miles from the Justice Court. Audiovisual proceedings such as arraignments are conducted several times a week. On occasion, entry of plea and sentencing has been held with the defendant's counsel either in the justice courtroom or with the defendant at the jail. Audiovisual proceedings between the jail and the court have been conducted in excess of 10 years. Approximately 6 years past, the audiovisual equipment was updated and the Court now has the capacity to conduct audiovisual conferencing with the two other justice courts in Lyon County.
