2 appearing telephonically. The court reporter is able to hear
3 and understand all parties, and transcribe the proceedings as
4 appropriate.


5 Additionally, conferencing may be done with multiple

7 To the Ninth Judicial District Court's knowledge, no party
8 has requested to appear pursuant to ADKT 424 specifically.
9 However, the court regularly grants informal requests (by
