ORDER SUSPENDING FORECLOSURE MEDIATION RULE 24


WHEREAS, on June 30, 2009, this court adopted rules for the foreclosure mediation program established by AB 149, and


WHEREAS, the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature passed Senate Bill 512, ending the foreclosure mediation program effective June 30, 2017, and


WHEREAS, this court has concluded that the advisory committee provided by Foreclosure Mediation Rule (FMR) 24 is no longer needed, accordingly


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the provisions of FMR 24 are suspended until further order of this court, effective immediately.


It is so ORDERED.




