ORDER

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2009, this court adopted rules for the foreclosure mediation program established by AB 149, and

WHEREAS, the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature passed Senate Bill 512, ending the foreclosure mediation program effective June 30, 2017, accordingly

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the last day that parties can request a mediation under the program is December 31, 2016; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all mediations must be completed by April 30, 2017; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the district courts may not remand any cases for further mediation after March 31, 2017; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all pending mediations must be completed no later than April 30, 2017, or the request for mediation will be declined and the \$200.00 fee paid by both the homeowner and the lender will be refunded.

It is so ORDERED.
