I, JONATHAN VANBOSKERCK, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. This Court may extend the time to file an Answering Brief upon a showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3)(D); SCR 250(6)(e).

The State's Answering Brief on the instant matter is currently due on July 20, 2012 following FIVE extensions of time granted to the Appellant. This is a direct appeal from a Judgment of Conviction in a Death Penalty case. Appellant's Opening Brief is over one hundred (100) pages and addresses twenty (20) issues with various sub issues.
