3 Obviously, this Court is going to dictate the questioning and issues it wants to address during
4 oral argument. However, by allowing Mr. O’Mara to address the Court regarding the statutory
5 issues during Respondents’ first 10 minutes, and then allow Mr. Goodenow to address the Court
6 regarding the constitutional issues with Respondents’ remaining time, Respondents will be more
7 prepared and able to address all of the Court’s questions regarding these important statutory,
8 constitutional and public policy issues that may be at stake.

9 Therefore, Respondents seek this Court’s permission to allow both of their counsel to address
10 this Court during oral argument.
