O R D E R

This is an automatic appeal from a judgment of conviction and sentence of death. NRS 177.055. The record on appeal having been filed on October 9, 2000, appellant's opening brief was due to be filed on or before December 18, 2000. See SCR 250(6)(d). On December 28, 2001, this court granted appellant a sixty-day extension of time to file the opening brief. On February 28, 2001, this court granted appellant an additional forty-five day extension, until April 2, 2001, to file the opening brief.

To date, appellant has failed to file the opening brief. Appellant shall, within ten (10) days of the date of this order, file and serve the opening brief or show cause why sanctions should not be imposed against counsel for appellant.
