PETITION

On November 16, 2011, the Order Establishing Pilot Program for the Transitioning into Practice was filed with the Court. The TIP program pairs newly admitted attorneys with experienced attorneys in good standing with the State Bar of Nevada (State Bar) practicing for seven years or more. Mentor matches are based on the area of law in which the mentor and new attorney practice as well as geographic location. Mentors and new attorneys may also designate with whom they would like to be paired.

To serve, mentors must complete an online application that gathers pertinent information about the mentor, such as area(s) of practice, that requires the mentor to attest to having a \$500,000 minimum malpractice insurance policy (private practitioners only) and that grants permission for disclosure to the Board of Governors all discipline files and records. Mentor applications are screened by the TIP Standing Committee and are approved by the Board of Governors.

The Board of Governors hereby petitions this Court to appoint the following mentors to serve as TIP mentors:


