MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR REPLY BRIEF (SECOND REQUEST)

Appellant hereby moves for a 30-day extension of time for filing the reply brief. The brief is presently due on January 9, 2013. Therefore, appellant seeks an extension until February 8, 2013. This is appellant's second request for an extension.

This is an appeal from a personal injury judgment of more than \$6 million. Respondent received two extensions of time for the answering brief, and respondent received permission to exceed the normal word limitation.

The trial lasted more than two weeks, and the appendix consists of more than 3,200 pages, including the lengthy trial transcript.

Appellant's counsel was on a long-standing vacation for a full week in early December, and he was out of the office for several days during the holidays, dealing with personal family matters. Appellant's counsel also had to prepare a response to a child custody fast track statement in another appeal, which took priority over other appeal matters.

Appellant's counsel has been working diligently on the reply brief in this case. Unfortunately, the answering brief is deficient in its failure to cite relevant legal authority, and in its failure to provide adequate citations to the appendix. The answering brief also does not accurately characterize many of the contentions and issues in this appeal. Consequently, appellant's counsel has needed to spend extra time analyzing the answering brief and the appendix, in preparation of the reply brief.

Appellant's counsel has been unable to finish the brief within the present time limit. An additional 30 days is needed for drafting the remaining parts of the reply brief, and for reviewing, editing and finalizing the brief (and the reply appendix).

Accordingly, appellant requests an extension of time until February 8, 2013, for filing the reply brief. This motion is made in good faith and is not intended to cause unnecessary delay of this appeal.
