



ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On November 26, 2013, the parties stipulated to a fourth extension of time for respondent to file the answering brief on the basis that the parties are continuing to work on settlement negotiations. Because NRAP 31(b)(2) limits briefing-extension stipulations to a total of 30 days, we construe the parties' November 26 stipulation as an unopposed motion for an extension of time to file the answering brief.
