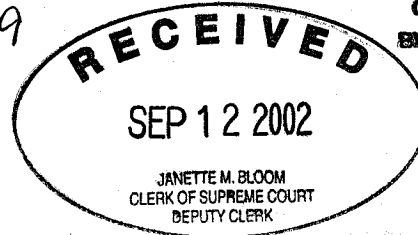

Dear Ms. Bloom:

One of my staff members had a telephone conversation with one of yours today, at which time an inquiry was made as to procedures, if any, for inclusion of Robert Cerceo in the "For Petitioner" listing at the top of the opinion as finally printed.

We were advised to send a short letter request to you, specifying Bob's involvement in the appeal. Bob was involved in every aspect of the case at the trial level, including our original intake, and even a trip to Texas in the middle of the litigation in an effort to take custody of the children and return them to our court. He acted as co-counsel throughout the district court litigation, and alone did the last day's closing argument.

On the appeal, he participated directly in the drafting of the writ petition (facts, Hague, and jurisdiction sections), although I did the final edit, and I signed it. He participated in the appellate settlement conference as co-counsel, and attended the oral argument before the Court at counsel table (although I presented on behalf of Petitioner) and providing to me portions of the record and other documents during that argument. His involvement was substantial at all phases of the case, at trial and on appeal, and I believe that it would be appropriate to list his name with mine as Counsel for Ms. Vaile.

I understand that you are only in the office intermittently in the immediate future (by the way – Congratulations!) There is no emergency involved in this request, of course, but I would appreciate
