On June 1, 2012, the Court imposed the sentence against KUPA'A KEA where he is to serve two (2) consecutive terms of a minimum thirty-five (35) months to one hundred fifty-six (156) months for Counts I and II as described in the Information and defined as, Battery with a Deadly Weapon causing substantial bodily harm, a violation of NRS 200.481(2)(e), a felony;
