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I. STATEMENT OF INTEREST

The Truckee Meadows Water Authority (“TMWA”), the Southern Nevada Water Authority (“SNWA”), the Cities of Fernley, Minden, Carson City, Henderson, North Las Vegas, and Las Vegas, Gardnerville Ranchos General Improvement District (collectively, the “Amici”) are the wholesale and retail water providers to approximately 2.45 million Nevada residents and over 37 million visitors every year. Together, the Amici are responsible for serving water to about 90% of Nevada’s population.

The Amici have a significant interest in ensuring that Nevada courts maintain the State Engineer’s full statutory authority to grant and administer water rights in the state.

Nevada is the driest state in the country and the development of new and existing municipal water resources will often impact existing water rights. Most new water development occurs from groundwater aquifers, and because all groundwater pumping lowers the water level in the aquifer, some pumping impacts are inevitable. Without the ability to eliminate potential conflicts with existing rights by requiring such impacts to be mitigated, the State Engineer would be compelled to deny water right applications and change applications in the vast majority of cases. The impact on Amici and their customers – and anyone else that diverts large amounts of water for purposes that essentially fuel Nevada’s economy

– simply cannot be overstated. Therefore, Amici hereby present their views on the proper interpretation and application of NRS chapters 533 and 534. As political subdivisions of the State of Nevada, the Amici are authorized to file this brief in accordance with NRAP 29(a).

II. SUMMARY OF ARGUMENT

Eureka County argues that the State Engineer must deny new groundwater appropriations any time he finds that the requested diversion will impact existing rights. The result advocated by Eureka County does not change even if the State Engineer also finds that the impacts can be fully mitigated and even if the proposed diversion might benefit hundreds, thousands or hundreds of thousands of Nevadans. Eureka County's position is contrary to the State Engineer's historic practices, unsupported by applicable statutes and case law, and is incompatible with the doctrine of prior appropriation. Moreover, Eureka County's position is untethered to the reality of modern groundwater development and would significantly hamper the ability of municipal water purveyors to provide future – and existing – water service to their customers. Accordingly, Eureka County's argument should be rejected.

III. ARGUMENT

The State Engineer has authority under Nevada water law to consider the availability and effectiveness of mitigation measures in determining whether to

grant groundwater applications. NRS 534.110(4)-(5). Without this authority, the State Engineer's ability to grant new groundwater appropriations and change applications and maximize the beneficial use of water in Nevada will be severely limited. The Amici in many cases would be unable to meet the future and existing water demands of Nevada communities without this tool.

A. Eureka County's Argument Would Limit Ability of Municipal Water Purveyors to Secure New Water Supplies and Maintain Existing Water Service.

Eureka County argues that the State Engineer cannot consider mitigation requirements when determining whether a proposed use of water will *conflict* with existing water rights. Eureka County Opening Brief ("OB") pp.52, 59. Instead, Eureka County urges this Court to hold that evidence of *impacts* to an existing right is equivalent to a finding of a *conflict* with an existing right, regardless of whether the predicted impacts can be mitigated. OB pp.41-46, 52 ("NRS 533.370(2) does not authorize the State Engineer to *mitigate the impacts* to existing rights and issue the permits"). This proposition is an unreasonable, unrealistic interpretation of Nevada water law that would severely limit the ability of any potential appropriator in Nevada – e.g. irrigators, domestic wells, water purveyors, or other, to file to appropriate new, or expand and maintain existing water supplies.

The State Engineer's authority to require mitigation is essential to maximizing and making more efficient use of Nevada's water resources. Nevada

is the driest state in the United States and its water resources are becoming ever more developed and scarce. *See Bacher v. State Engineer*, 122 Nev. 1110, 1116, 146 P.3d 793, 797 (2006) (water in Nevada “is a precious and increasingly scarce resource”). Even where groundwater remains available for appropriation, over time the pumping of a new appropriation may theoretically cause at least some impact on existing water rights. Under Eureka County’s rule, the vast majority of new appropriations would be denied as a result of such theoretical impacts, even if the impacts can be avoided by reasonable mitigation measures.

Nevada water purveyors are working to secure future water resources for their citizens and communities, and large amounts of taxpayer dollars have been spent to pursue and develop these resources. At least 292 municipal water applications are pending before the State Engineer, and at least 69 applications are in groundwater basins that have available water supplies but also contain small existing water rights. *See Attachment A, Pending Municipal Water Right Applications in Basins with Available Perennial Yield.*

The fallout from Eureka County’s new rule would not be confined to the perpetual non-use of available water and the constant smothering of new economic activities. In addition to governing new appropriations, NRS 533.370(2) prohibits the approval of applications to change the way existing water rights are used if such change will conflict with other existing rights. Simply stated, Nevada’s

growth and development will be paralyzed if the State Engineer is prevented from granting applications with mitigation requirements that avoid conflicts with existing rights.

Currently over 675 change applications are pending before the State Engineer. *See* Attachment B, Pending Change Applications. Of those applications, 197 are for municipal purposes. *See* Attachment C, Pending Municipal Change Applications. Municipal water purveyors file change applications to manage their existing water supplies and assure adequate drinking water for their customers. Drilling new wells to replace old wells or develop better quality water is allowed only through approved change applications. Locations where these change applications are filed often have existing water rights that may be impacted by relocating wells, and the State Engineer has required mitigation of such impacts when these change applications are approved. The interpretation of NRS 533.370(2) that Eureka County seeks would limit the ability of the State Engineer to approve these applications, and likewise, limit the ability of municipal water purveyors to assure water supplies for their customers.

B. The State Engineer May Grant a Water Right Application if He Finds that Impacts on an Existing Water Right Can Be Mitigated.

Nevada water law does provide for denial of a water right application if the proposed use of water will *conflict* with existing rights. NRS 533.370(2). The fact that a proposed use may have an impact on an existing water right does not

constitute a *conflict*, however, particularly if regulatory requirements (i.e. mitigation) are required in the permit conditions. The term “impact” has a distinctly different meaning than “conflict.” While *impact* means “to have a direct effect or . . . impinge on,” a *conflict* is an impact that rises to the level of “competitive or opposing action of incompatibles.”¹ In turn, incompatible means “incapable of . . . harmonious coexistence.”² Based upon these definitions (and ordinary, everyday use of the words), a conflict with an existing right is one that is irreconcilable, but an impact is a direct effect that can be mitigated.³

Nevada statutes clearly authorize new groundwater appropriators to reasonably impact existing groundwater rights. Groundwater rights entitle the holder only to a specific quantity of water, and “[i]t is a condition of each appropriation of groundwater” that the water table at their well can be “reasonably lower[ed].” NRS 534.110(4).⁴ A reasonable impact to a groundwater right, therefore, is not a conflict with that right, and the State Engineer has the discretion

to determine what constitutes a reasonable lowering of the water table at the time pumping actually lowers the water table. NRS 534.110(4).

Impacts, but not conflicts, are also permissible between a new groundwater appropriation and an existing surface water right. The State Engineer can grant a groundwater right, even if evidence exists that the new right will cause the water table near an existing surface water right to decline. NRS 534.110(5).⁵ In such a case, however, the State Engineer must place express conditions on the new groundwater right so the “rights of holders of existing appropriations” can be satisfied. NRS 534.110(5). This statute makes no distinction between groundwater rights and surface water rights and only refers to the “rights of holders of existing appropriations.” *Id.* Therefore, the State Engineer has authority to impose express conditions (e.g. mitigation) to ensure that both existing groundwater rights and existing surface water rights can be satisfied and as long as existing rights can be satisfied, there is no *conflict* with existing rights.

One of the most important “express conditions” that the State Engineer can place of a new groundwater right is mitigation. In the case of water development and use, mitigation can mean action that reduces the severity of impacts to an existing water right. Mitigation measures can include, but are not limited to, providing financial compensation, supplying alternative water, altering pumping dates, times or locations, reducing pumping amounts, and, in some cases, ceasing pumping. In the context of Nevada water law, the State Engineer defines “mitigation” to mean “[a]ction taken to avoid, reduce the severity of, or eliminate an adverse impact.”⁶ Successful mitigation ensures the holder of the existing right will receive the same amount of water, at the same point of diversion and place of use, and during the same time period. Since a water right in Nevada is a right to beneficially *use* water (not ownership of the water itself), when mitigation is successful there can be no *conflict* with existing rights. *See Desert Irr., Ltd. v. State*, 113 Nev. 1049, 1059, 944 P.2d 835, 842 (1997) (“Indeed, even those holding certificated, vested, or perfected water rights do not own or acquire title to water. They merely enjoy the right to beneficial use.”) Some impacts can be easily mitigated, while other impacts may be more difficult, or even impossible, to mitigate. The State Engineer is obligated to weigh whether mitigation is possible

when evidence of impacts exists, and, if supported by substantial evidence, his finding of fact regarding the successfulness of mitigation must be upheld.

Nevada water law statutes recognize the concept of mitigation when impacts occur between new groundwater rights and domestic wells. The State Engineer is required to include an express permit condition that limits or prohibits any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well, “unless the holder of the permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that *mitigate* those adverse effects.” NRS 534.110(5)(b) (emphasis added). Further, the Legislature has also declared the policy of Nevada is to protect domestic wells from “unreasonable adverse effects which are caused by municipal, quasi-municipal or industrial uses and which cannot reasonably be *mitigated*.”⁷ NRS 533.024(1)(b) (emphasis added). Hence, the Legislature has recognized that mitigation may be considered by the State Engineer.

Nevada case law and statutes regarding adjudications of surface water and groundwater systems also recognize the concept of mitigation as a way to avoid conflicts with existing rights. The State Engineer is vested with the authority under Nevada water law to adjudicate stream systems and groundwater basins.

NRS 533.090; NRS 534.100. The State Engineer also has the inherent authority to consider how a basin or stream system should be managed in order to protect senior water rights holders from impairment by junior rights. *Id.*; *Ormsby County v. Kearney*, 37 Nev. 314, 352, 142 P. 803, 810 (1914) (validating the State Engineer’s ongoing authority to regulate stream systems). The countless decrees and adjudications undertaken by the State Engineer since the creation of his Office are evidence of the power of the State Engineer to impose regulatory measures to manage and control the use of water rights and avoid conflicts between water right users.

Nevada statutes clearly authorize the State Engineer to consider mitigation measures before he finds whether a conflict exists with existing rights. Accordingly, Eureka County’s argument should be rejected.

C. Principles of Prior Appropriation Allow Mitigation of Impacts to Existing Water Rights.

Eureka County properly ascribes the origins of Nevada water law to the doctrine of prior appropriation. But Eureka County ignores the role of “mitigation” in the common law of prior appropriation. Prior to the adoption of Nevada’s water law, courts in Nevada managed water rights through court decrees that resolved disputes between junior and senior water right owners. *See e.g. Jones v. Adams*, 19 Nev. 78, 6 P. 442 (1885). These decrees resolved conflicts between water users and govern water systems to this day. Decree provisions resolved

conflicts by limiting the time and quantity of water use, and, in some cases even dictated the quantity of water that can be approved in future change applications. Each provision protected existing rights from impacts that would otherwise have caused conflicts.

This common law was codified between 1905 and 1913 into NRS chapters 533 and 534. The same common law was codified in other western states, including New Mexico, Utah and Washington. Case law and statutes in those states have explored how conflicts with existing water rights can be avoided through the mitigation of impacts. These cases and statutes are informative to the nature of Nevada's common law, which was codified in NRS 533.370, and which authorizes the State Engineer to consider evidence of mitigation when making a conflict determination. The cases and statutes cited by Eureka County from these states support the conclusion that prior appropriation principles incorporate mitigation as a tool to avoid conflicts with existing water rights.

In New Mexico, the same conflicts determination is codified and directs the state engineer to grant an application if the “the proposed appropriation would not *impair* existing water rights from the source....” N.M. STAT. § 72-12-3(E) (2012) (emphasis added). The New Mexico State Engineer has the authority to consider and impose conditions and mitigation measures when making an impairment determination. According to the New Mexico Supreme Court, a stipulation which

imposes mitigation measures “is both a proposed condition to [an] application and an evidentiary item on the issue of impairment.” *City of Roswell v. Berry*, 452 P.2d 179, 182 (N.M. 1969). Therefore, in New Mexico, the availability of mitigation measures is an inherent part of the impairment analysis. *See City of Albuquerque v. Reynolds*, 379 P.2d 73, 81 (N.M. 1963) (stating “[t]his power to impose suitable conditions is inherent in the broader power to prohibit” an application).

In Utah, a new appropriation or change “may not be made if it *impairs* a vested water right without just compensation.” UTAH CODE ANN. § 73-3-3 (2012) (emphasis added). However, the Utah State Engineer “may not reject a permanent or temporary change application for the sole reason that the change would impair a vested water right.” *Id.* The Utah courts “must determine whether there was a showing of reason to believe that such changes can be made without impairing vested rights of others.” *Provo Bench Canal & Irr. Co. v. Linke*, 296 P.2d 723, 724 (Utah 1956). The “reason to believe” standard involves an examination of the totality of the evidence. *See generally Searle v. Milburn Irr. Co.*, 133 P.3d 382, 393-395 (Utah 2006) (articulating the burden of proof required to give reason to believe changes can be made without impairment). Thus, even when the Utah State Engineer finds an application will impact an existing right, he can grant the application if he has reason to believe the rights of others will not be impaired.

The authority of a water administrator to consider mitigation as part of a conflicts analysis is also express in the laws of Colorado. In Colorado, if a proposed water application would cause “injurious effect,” the referee or the water judge must afford the applicant with an “opportunity to propose terms or conditions that would prevent such injurious effect.” *See* COLO. REV. STAT. § 37-92-305(3)(a) (2012).

The prior appropriation doctrine in Nevada has always allowed for mitigation opportunities to be weighed as part of the water administration process. The conflicts analysis in NRS 533.370(2) codified that allowance. Other prior appropriation states have also codified their common law to allow mitigation options to be considered before a conflicts or impairment determination is concluded. Therefore, Eureka County’s argument to the contrary is without merit.

D. State Engineer Properly Issued Permits Subject to Mitigation Plan and Properly Articulated Environmental Soundness Standard.

The District Court properly held that in addition to taking a mitigation plan into account when evaluating conflicts with existing rights, the State Engineer can determine whether mitigation can work in the future to address unreasonable impacts, and require a mitigation plan when determining whether NRS 533.370(3)(c) is satisfied. Joint Appendix (“JA”) 6860. Monitoring and mitigation plans are a practical necessity for municipal purveyors and are regularly

used by the State Engineer. The District Court also properly concluded that the State Engineer may consider the effectiveness of mitigation when determining the “environmental soundness” of an interbasin water transfer under NRS 533.370(3)(c). As that court recognized, the State Engineer has the discretion to interpret the meaning of the term “environmentally sound” in NRS 533.370(3)(c). JA 6863.

The State Engineer determined that the meaning of “environmentally sound” is “whether the use of the water is sustainable over the long-term without unreasonable impacts to the water resources and the hydrologic-related natural resources that are dependent on those water resources.” JA 6860. Further, the State Engineer found that there can be a reasonable impact on hydrologic related natural resources, so long as a monitoring, management and mitigation plan can ensure that the proposed transfer remains environmentally sound. *Id.* Whether this standard is satisfied is a question of fact to be decided by the State Engineer, and the District Court properly applied the standard of deference to the State Engineer by limiting its review to whether the State Engineer’s factual finding was supported by substantial evidence. JA 6863. Accordingly, the District Court’s appropriate interpretation of these statutes takes into account the proper role of mitigation in the water right application process.

E. Holders of Existing Water Rights Are Not Denied Due Process when State Engineer Requires Mitigation.

Eureka County and other Appellants argue the State Engineer’s decision to impose mitigation as an express condition of a groundwater right denies procedural due process to existing water right owners. OB p.49; Appellants Opening Brief, p. 22.

Governmental entities may not deprive a person of “life, liberty, or property, without due process of law.” U.S. Const. amend. XIV § 1; Nev. Const. art.1 § 8(5). “A procedural due process claim has two distinct elements: (1) a deprivation of a constitutionally protected life, liberty or property interest, and (2) a denial of adequate procedural protections.” *Brewster v. Bd. of Educ. of Lynwood Unified Sch. Dist.*, 149 F.3d 971, 982 (9th Cir. 1998). Interested parties must receive an “opportunity to be heard at a meaningful time and in a meaningful manner.” *J.D. Constr. v. IBEX Int’l Grp.*, 126 Nev. ___, ___, 240 P.3d 1033, 1041 (2010) (quoting *Mathews v. Eldridge*, 424 U.S. 319, 333, 96 S. Ct. 893, 902 (1976)).

First, although water rights are real property, an existing water right owner is not deprived of property when the State Engineer determines that there will be no *conflict* with the existing right. In such a case, property is not deprived because the existing water right retains the same priority and remains entitled to the same protection (statutory and Constitutional) if conflicts do occur. The State Engineer has a continuing duty to regulate groundwater, specifically through ongoing

investigations and limiting withdrawals “to conform to priority rights.” NRS 534.110(6). The State Engineer must also restrict any additional wells in a groundwater basin if he “determines that additional wells would cause an undue interference with existing wells.” NRS 534.110(8). Mitigation does not eliminate the State Engineer’s continuing authority and responsibility to protect existing rights, nor does it deprive existing water right owners of the continued protection of the State Engineer. Therefore, there is no deprivation of a constitutionally protected interest.

Second, existing water right owners are given a full opportunity to be heard regarding the effectiveness of mitigation. During the application process, existing water right owners can file written protests with the State Engineer setting forth protest grounds relating to mitigation. NRS 533.365. The State Engineer has discretion whether to hold a hearing on any protests and protestants have no absolute right to a hearing. NRS 533.365(4). However, when the State Engineer determines it is necessary to hold a hearing, protestants receive notice of the hearing and are given an opportunity to provide information relating to their protests. NRS 533.365(5). At the hearing, protestants have another opportunity to present evidence. During the application process, the real issue with regard to mitigation is whether the facts and circumstances demonstrate that potential mitigation options can effectively prevent *conflicts*, not what specific mitigation

measures may ultimately be used to prevent *conflicts*. Through the protest and hearing procedures, existing water right owners have a full opportunity to be heard on whether potential mitigation options can be effective.

After the application process, existing water right owners receive additional procedural protections. Existing water right owners can correspond directly with the State Engineer, and in some cases are involved in developing the mitigation plan. Existing water right owners can petition for judicial review of State Engineer decisions regarding what specific mitigation measures will be required, and how mitigation measures are implemented. NRS 533.450(1). In that event, the existing water right owner will receive a “full opportunity to be heard... before judgment is pronounced.” NRS 533.450(2). Therefore, existing water right owners will continue to receive an opportunity to be heard at a meaningful time and in a meaningful manner. *J.D. Constr.*, 240 P.3d at 1041. At the same time, of course, existing water rights owners are always protected if mitigation measures are not ultimately effective. *See e.g.* NRS 534.110(6) and 534.110(8) (explained above). Therefore, existing water right owners receive adequate procedural protections both during and after the application process.

Accordingly, the due process argument should be rejected.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the District Court's order should be affirmed.
