On July 31, 2014, this court entered an order appointing the Nevada Bar Foundation (NBF) as the designated SCR 216 IOLTA foundation, effective August 14, 2014. Pursuant to SCR 216(a), the NBF is required to maintain adequate reserves as approved by this court.


On November 10, 2020, the NBF requested permission to draw down its reserve fund by \$300,000 to ameliorate the reduction in funding to Nevada's core legal service providers resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. We approve the request and grant permission to the NBF to draw down its reserve funds by \$300,000.
