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MEMORANDUM

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a sixty (60) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief under NRAP 31(b)(3) and SCR 250(7)(d).

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a post-conviction petition for writ of habeas corpus in a death penalty case. Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal on October 22, 2012, yet ultimately did not file the current Opening Brief with this Court until January 8, 2014. This delay was due to Appellant filing numerous Motions to Extend Time, followed by the Court striking Appellant's initial Opening Brief because it failed to comply with the page limitations allowed by NRAP 23(a)(7)(ii).

Appellant filed four (4) Motions to Extend Time. The first was filed on February 21, 2013, wherein Appellant requested an additional ninety (90) days to file the Opening Brief. This Court granted the Motion making said brief due May 22, 2013. On May 22, 2013, Appellant filed his second Motion to Extend Time again requesting an additional ninety (90) days to file the Opening Brief. This Court granted the request making the brief due on August 20, 2013. On August 20, 2013, Appellant filed his third Motion to Extent Time this time requesting an additional forty-five (45) days to file the Opening Brief. Again, this Court granted the Motion making the brief due October 4, 2013. Then on October 4, 2013,

Appellant filed his fourth Motion to Extend Time requesting an additional forty-five (45) days to file the Opening Brief. This motion was granted giving Appellant until November 18, 2013, to file the Opening Brief.

Then on November 18, 2013, Appellant filed his initial Opening Brief, along with a Motion to Enlarge Page Limitations and a twenty-one (21) volume appendix. On December 6, 2013, this Court denied Appellant's Motion to Enlarge Page Limitations and struck the initial Opening Brief. Appellant then filed a conforming Opening Brief on January 8, 2014.

No Motions for Extension of Time have been requested or granted to the State, and its Answering Brief is currently due on February 7, 2014. As good cause for the extension, the State cites the following: 1) the Opening Brief is sixty-two (62) pages long and raises twelve (12) grounds for relief, which are based on a twenty-one (21) volume Appellant's Appendix; 2) Appellant was convicted in 1996, and therefore this case has a long and complex history; and 3) this Court has granted Appellant's four (4) Motions to Extend Time while this is the State's first request for additional time.

Accordingly, the State respectfully moves for an enlargement of time of sixty (60) days, making said answering brief due on Tuesday, April 8, 2014. This will give the State sufficient time to adequately respond fully to the material in

Appellant's Opening Brief and sort through the voluminous appendix submitted to the Court.
