ORDER SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

This is an appeal from a district court order denying a post-conviction petition for a writ of habeas corpus. We previously remanded this matter for the district court to appoint counsel to represent appellant. The district court has appointed attorney Julian R. Gregory as counsel for appellant.

Appellant shall have 20 days from the date of this order to file and serve (1) a transcript request form or certificate that no transcripts will be requested, NRAP 9(a)(1)(C), (3)(A), and (2) a docketing statement, NRAP 14. Appellant shall have 120 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions.
