## **MEMORANDUM**

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a THIRTY (30) day enlargement of time in which to file its Answering Brief pursuant to NRAP 31. No previous extensions have been filed by or granted to the State.

The Answering Brief is currently due on November 18, 2013. Appellant has filed one previous motion which was granted by this Court on July 25, 2013, enlarging the time to file the Opening Brief by NINETY (90) days.
