ORDER RE: ENTRY OF WRITTEN ORDER  
AND DIRECTING TRANSMISSION OF RECORD

This is an appeal from a district court order resolving a pretrial petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Appellant filed the notice of appeal in district court on March 27, 2013. Based on our review of the district court minute entries, it appears that the district court orally granted the petition in part on March 27, 2013. It further appears, however, that a written order granting the petition has not been entered in this matter. "A notice of appeal filed after the announcement of a decision, sentence or order—but before entry of the judgment or order—shall be treated as filed after such entry and on the day thereof." NRAP 4(b)(2). Upon the entry of an order resolving the petition, appellate jurisdiction will be vested in this court. *See Sheriff v. Gillock*, 112 Nev. 213, 912 P.2d 274 (1996).

The district court shall have 30 days from the date of this order to: (1) enter a written order or (2) inform this court that it is reconsidering its decision. In the event the district court enters a written order (or has already entered a written order of which this court is

unaware), the clerk of the district court shall immediately transmit a certified copy of the order to the clerk of this court.

Additionally, NRS 34.575(3) provides that when an appeal is taken from an order granting a pretrial petition for a writ of habeas corpus, the clerk of the district court shall certify and transmit the record on appeal to the Supreme Court and, if the appellant or respondent demands it, transcripts of the proceedings in the district court. Accordingly, the clerk of the district court shall have 30 days from the date of this order to transmit to the clerk of this court a certified copy of the complete district court record of the proceedings below on respondent's petition. Upon the filing of the record in this court, this appeal shall stand submitted for decision without further briefing or oral argument unless the court otherwise orders.

It is so ORDERED.
