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#### MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

#### <u>I.</u>

#### **FACTS**

Petitioner-Appellant's Opening Brief currently is due on January 28, 2014. Michael Laurence, Esq., is responsible for drafting the Opening Brief.

On May 7, 2013, the District Court granted the Application of Michael Laurence, Esq. to appear as counsel pro hac vice, in the Petitioner-Appellant's habeas corpus proceedings. Mr. Laurence is the Executive Director of the Habeas Corpus Resource Center, an agency in the Judicial Branch of the State of California that represents indigent men and women under sentence of death in state and federal habeas corpus proceedings and in executive clemency proceedings. Mr. Laurence's appearance in this matter, however, is conducted solely in his capacity as a private attorney and on his own personal time.

This extension is requested because counsel for Petitioner-Appellant took leave from work at the Habeas Corpus Resource Center and planned to complete the majority of the drafting of Opening Brief from December 21, 2013, through January 5, 2014. On December 23, 2013, counsel for Petitioner-Appellant was in an accident as a pedestrian and sustained multiple injuries to his head, face, and body. As a result, he was unable to work on Appellant's Opening Brief during the period that had been set aside. A motion for extension 18 of time for filing a brief shall include the 19 following: 20 (I) The date when the brief is due; 21 (ii) The number of extensions of time previously granted (including a 5-day telephonic extension), and if extensions 22 were granted, the original date when the brief was due; 23 24 (iii) Whether any previous requests for extensions of time have been denied or 25 denied in part; 26 (iv) The reasons or grounds why an extension is necessary; and

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(v) The length of the extension requester and the date on which the brief would become due. III. **CONCLUSION** For the reasons stated, and in accordance with NRAP 31(b)(3), the Appellant respectfully requests an extension of twenty-one (21) days to file the Opening Brief and Appendix, through and including Tuesday, February 18, 2014.
