## MEMORANDUM

I, JONATHAN E. VANBOSKERCK, am the supervising attorney in the above-captioned case. The State is requesting a thirty (30) day extension of time in which to file its Answering Brief under NRAP 31.

This is an appeal from a Judgment of Conviction. Barral was convicted after a jury trial of two (2) counts of Sexual Assault with a Minor under Fourteen Years of Age. See Judgment of Conviction filed September 23, 2013. Appellant filed a timely Notice of Appeal to this Court in this matter on September 27, 2013.

This Court may extend the time to file an Answering Brief for a case upon a showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3). Appellant has previously filed two Motions to Extend Time in the instant appeal, both of which this Court granted. After receiving two extensions of time, Appellant filed a four-volume Appellant's Appendix and an Opening Brief that raises eight (8) issues for review and exceeds this Court's standard page allowance. Therefore, the State hereby makes this first request to extend time to allow additional time to fully brief and respond to Appellant's claims for this Court.
