*ORDER REINSTATING BRIEFING*

In its timely response to this court's order to show cause, which questioned whether the claims involving Steven Zlatt, M.D., Inc., had been resolved, appellant submitted a copy of a September 3, 2014, district court default judgment against Steven Zlatt, M.D., Inc. Accordingly, it appears that a final judgment has been entered,<sup>1</sup> and this



appeal may proceed. NRAP 3A(b)(1); *Lee v. GNLV Corp.*, 116 Nev. 424, 996 P.2d 416 (2000); *see also* NRAP 4(a)(6).

We reinstate the briefing schedule as follows. Appellant shall have 60 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with NRAP 31(a)(1).
