*ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR TRANSMISSION OF ORIGINAL
EXHIBIT*

Appellant has filed a motion for the transmission of an original district court exhibit. The motion is unopposed. Appellant represents that the exhibit is necessary for this court's review of the appeal. The exhibit consists of a "digitized video recording" of appellant's interrogation and is identified as State's Exhibit 243, and appears to have been admitted into evidence during the trial proceedings conducted on May 20, 2010.
