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## **MEMORANDUM**

I, STEVEN S. OWENS, am a duly licensed attorney in the State of Nevada and am employed by the Clark County District Attorney's Office.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due April 10, 2015. This is an appeal from the denial of petition for writ of habeas corpus (post-conviction). Pursuant to SCR 250(7)(d) and NRAP 31(b)(3)(D), an initial request for extension of time in a capital case will be granted on a clear showing of good cause. Subsequent extensions of time will not be granted except upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need.

The State requests 30 days up to and including May 11, 2015, within which to file Respondent's Answering Brief. The State has completed a draft of the Answering Brief which is over 100 pages and requests additional time in which to review and finalize the Brief. After receiving three extensions of time totaling 212 days, Appellant filed a 135 page Opening Brief, and a 43 volume appendix. Appellant raises various complex issues, many of which must be addressed on the merits. Further, the procedural history of this case includes three penalty hearings and multiple appeals. Therefore, considering the complexity of the issues and procedural history, the extensive constitutional issues involved, and the severity of Appellant's sentence, the State hereby makes this second request to extend time to allow additional. This motion is made in good faith and not for the purposes of undue delay.
