

Dear Honorable Chief Justice Parraguire:

As a Nevada lawyer with provisional certificates from the State of Nevada and local business licenses to own and operate medical marijuana establishments under Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") Chapter 453A, I am respectfully requesting a continuance of the hearing to consider ADKT 0495. The hearing is scheduled for July 7, 2016 at the Regional Justice Center.

I only recently discovered the Nevada Supreme Court was considering this amendment. The proposed rule could have a substantial impact on both my practice and investment in Organic Remedies LLC, a Nevada medical marijuana cultivation and dispensary business. Unfortunately, I will travel out of state with my family during the time of the scheduled meeting on a trip we have had planned for six months.

The Nevada Dispensary Association ("NDA"), with a group of concerned attorneys that includes myself, have contacted several professors who are concerned experts in professional ethics to obtain advice and possibly representation on this issue. The current deadline will likely prevent us from securing this representation in time for the meeting.

Therefore, I respectfully request that the Court continue the July 7, 2016 hearing to another date and time at the Regional Justice Center which would both allow me to attend and provide the NDA sufficient time to retain the assistance of someone who could thoroughly examine and expound upon the matters to be considered by the court.


