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MEMORANDUM

I, JONATHAN VANBOSKERCK, am a duly licensed attorney in the State of Nevada and am employed by the Clark County District Attorney's Office.

Respondent's Answering Brief is currently due June 19, 2015. This Court may extend the time to file a Respondent's Answering Brief upon a clear showing of good cause. NRAP 31(b)(3).
