*ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND STAYING REMITTITUR*

Appellant has moved to stay issuance of the remittitur, pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. Preliminarily, we grant appellant permission to file this proper person document and direct the clerk of this court to file the motion. *See* NRAP 46(b). Cause appearing, we grant the motion to stay the remittitur. *See* NRAP 41(b). Issuance of the remittitur shall be stayed until January 30, 2015. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by January 30, 2015, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall remain in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by January 30, 2015, the remittitur shall issue February 6, 2015.
