

ORDER DIRECTING ANSWER

This original petition for a writ of mandamus challenges a district court order granting a request for petitioner to be civilly committed and directing the record of the commitment to be included in the Nevada Records of Criminal History. Having reviewed the petition, it appears that petitioner has set forth issues of arguable merit and that petitioner may have no plain, speedy, and adequate remedy in the ordinary course of the law. Therefore, real party in interest, on behalf of respondents, shall have 30 days from the date of this order within which to file and serve an answer, including authorities, against issuance of the requested writ. Petitioner shall have 15 days from service of the answer to file and serve any reply.
