Smith, 98 Nev. 222 (1982) 3 prohibits any assignment of a legal malpractice action. 4 5 Appellant's Opening Brief is currently due on January 21, 2015. However, 6 Appellant's counsel, Eric Tran, Esq. has been ill for the past week.² In addition, this 7 case involves complex issues of law including, inter alia, whether a legal malpractice 8 9 action is assignable. This issue is of great importance and one that has not been fully 10 resolved in Nevada.
