
STIPULATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

[First Extension]



OWENS, Chief Deputy District Attorney, and hereby Stipulate, pursuant to **NRAP 26(d)** to an extension of time for the filing of the Appellant's Opening Brief. **Currently, the Opening brief in this case is due on October 6, 2014.** Appellant's counsel, having just completed filing the Opening Brief in another case before this Honorable Court on September 26, 2014, believes that Ten (10) days is simply an insufficient period of time to exercise and complete a due diligence preparation and filing of an Opening Brief for a client who is serving
