In the District Court, the Estate filed a Petition to Declare Revocation of Trust Agreement alleging that the decedent's last will and testament, which had been admitted to probate, acted as an instrument in writing to revoke the decedent's revocable living trust. In a Report and Recommendation, Probate Commissioner Wesley Yamashita recommended that the Estate's Petition be denied finding that the will did not revoke the Trust. The Estate filed an Objection to Report and Recommendation, which objection was heard by Eighth Judicial District Court Judge Gloria Sturman. Judge Sturman approved and adopted Commissioner Yamashita's Report and Recommendation resulting in the denial of the Estate's Petition to Declare Revocation of Trust Agreement. The Estate appeals the District Court's Order approving the Report and Recommendation.
- Indicate Whether the Case has Previously been the Subject of an Appeal or 1 Original Writ Proceeding in the Supreme Court. Upon information and belief, there has been no original writ proceeding in the Supreme Court. An appeal in this case is currently pending in the Supreme Court. The caption and Supreme Court docket number of the pending proceeding is as follows:

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- 12. Indicate Whether this Appeal Involves Child Custody or Visitation. This appeal does not involve child custody or visitation.
- 13. Indicate Whether this Appeal Involves the Possibility of Settlement, A settlement conference was held on April 22, 2014, in connection with the currently pending appeal in this matter. The Final Settlement Conference Status Report was filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court on May 5, 2014. As noted by Settlement Judge M. Nelson Segel in the Status Report, during the settlement conference the parties discussed, considered, and addressed all issues related to not only the pending appeal, but also related to the issues presented in the Order from which the Estate is now appealing. Both matters were fully addressed during the settlement conference. The settlement conference was unsuccessful and the parties have been unable to reach any settlement following the settlement conference, though efforts to do so have continued.

At this time, it appears that this appeal does not involve the possibility of settlement. As suggested by Settlement Judge Segel, the Estate does not believe that a further settlement conference related to this appeal would be of value. The Estate requests that the Supreme Court combine this appeal with the currently pending appeal noted in paragraph 11 above and schedule briefing accordingly.

## REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION RE: PHIL MARKOWITZ'S PETITION TO DECLARE REVOCATION OF TRUST AGREEMENT

This matter having come on for hearing on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013, at 9:30 a.m., on Phil Markowitz's Petition to Declare Revocation of Trust Agreement (hereafter "Markowitz Petition"), filed by Jonathan Barlow, Esq., of the law firm BARLOW FLAKE, LLP on behalf of Petitioner Philip Markowitz (hereafter "Markowitz"); William Fink (hereafter "Fink"), Trustee of the Leroy G. Black Trust 1992 Living Trust, having filed an Objection to said Petition by and

through his attorney of record, Michael A. Olsen, Esq. of the law firm of GOODSELL & OLSEN, LLP, the Court having reviewed the pleadings on file and entertained the arguments of Counsel at the hearing and being fully advised in the premises finds:

- Leroy G. Black (hereafter "Decedent") died on or about April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 in Clark County, Nevada.
- 2. The Decedent was the Trustor of the Leroy G. Black 1992 Living Trust, as Amended and Restated October 27, 2009 (hereafter collectively the "Black Trust").
- Prior to his death, Leroy Black had his estate planning documents prepared and his estate managed by Jeffrey Burr, Ltd. since 1994.
- 4. Following the Decedent's death, Markowitz produced a document, dated March 7, 2012 (hereafter "March 2012 Will") purporting to be the Last Will & Testament of Leroy G. Black.
- 5. The March 2012 Will was not prepared by Jeffrey Burr, Ltd. nor did it make reference to the previous estate planning work performed by Jeffrey Burr Ltd.
- 6. The March 2012 Will does not expressly revoke or even acknowledge the existence of the Black Trust.
- 7. The March 2012 Will is devoid of any express language revoking any prior estate planning instrument(s).
- 8. On August 5, 2012 Markowitz filed the Markowitz Petition with this Court arguing that the March 2012 Will acted as a revocation of the Black Trust.
- 9. Fink filed an Objection to the Markowitz Petition arguing, among other things, that the March 2012 Will did not contain any express language revoking the Black Trust nor did the Will, as a matter of law, revoke the extensive prior estate planning performed by the

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- 10. THE COURT FINDS, that having reviewed the pleadings on file, the March 2012 Will, and having considered the arguments of counsel at hearing, there are a number of reasons that, as a matter of law, the March 2012 Will did not act to revoke the Black Trust.
- THE COURT FURTHER FINDS, that the language of the March 2012 Will does not contain any express language expressly revoking, or even referencing, the Black Trust.

  Therefore, the March 2012 Will is not sufficiently clear to act as a revocation of the Black Trust.
- 12. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that because the Black Trust had been funded by the Decedent there is a clear legal distinction between the assets of the Black Trust and the assets of the estate subject to probate.
- 13. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the language contained in Section 2.1 of the March 2012 will referencing the giving of "my property, both real and personal," references the property of the Decedent, Leroy Black, which is subject to probate and governed by the March 2012 Will, and not the property owned by the Black Trust or any other corporate entity at the time of Decedent's death.
- Total Amendment and Restatement of the Leroy G. Black, 1992 Living Trust, dated October 27, 2009, (The 2009 Restatement) in the event the Decedent had intended to revoke his Trust via the March 2012 Will, he would have also been required to deliver the revoked portion of the Trust property to the Trustor. In other words the property would have been removed from the Black Trust and put back in Decedent's personal name, subjecting the property to probate and distribution in accordance with the March 2012Will. This did not occur as the Black Trust remained funded until decedent's death.

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15. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, in accordance with section 8.2 of the 200	19
Restatement, the Black Trust became irrevocable upon the death of the Decedent. Since the	
March 2012 Will was not effective until death, that instrument could not validly revoke the	
Trust. Restatement: Trusts, sec. 330 comment j, "if the settlor reserves a power to revoke the	
trust by a transaction inter vivos, as for example, by a notice to the trustee, he cannot revoke the	>
trust by his will."	

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that Philip Markowitz's Petition to Declare

Revocation of Trust Agreement is hereby denied for the reasons set forth hereinabove.

#### REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION RE: PHIL MARKOWITZ'S PETITION TO DECLARE REVOCATION OF TRUST AGREEMENT

This matter having come on for hearing on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2013, at 9:30 a.m., on Phil Markowitz's Petition to Declare Revocation of Trust Agreement (hereafter "Markowitz Petition"), filed by Jonathan Barlow, Esq., of the law firm BARLOW FLAKE, LLP on behalf of Petitioner Philip Markowitz (hereafter "Markowitz"); William Fink (hereafter "Fink"), Trustee of the Leroy G. Black Trust 1992 Living Trust, having filed an Objection to said Petition by and

through his attorney of record, Michael A. Olsen, Esq. of the law firm of GOODSELL & OLSEN, LLP, the Court having reviewed the pleadings on file and entertained the arguments of Counsel at the hearing and being fully advised in the premises finds:

- Leroy G. Black (hereafter "Decedent") died on or about April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 in Clark County, Nevada.
- 2. The Decedent was the Trustor of the Leroy G. Black 1992 Living Trust, as Amended and Restated October 27, 2009 (hereafter collectively the "Black Trust").
- 3. Prior to his death, Leroy Black had his estate planning documents prepared and his estate managed by Jeffrey Burr, Ltd. since 1994.
- 4. Following the Decedent's death, Markowitz produced a document, dated March 7, 2012 (hereafter "March 2012 Will") purporting to be the Last Will & Testament of Leroy G. Black.
- 5. The March 2012 Will was not prepared by Jeffrey Burr, Ltd. nor did it make reference to the previous estate planning work performed by Jeffrey Burr Ltd.
- 6. The March 2012 Will does not expressly revoke or even acknowledge the existence of the Black Trust.
- 7. The March 2012 Will is devoid of any express language revoking any prior estate planning instrument(s).
- 8. On August 5, 2012 Markowitz filed the Markowitz Petition with this Court arguing that the March 2012 Will acted as a revocation of the Black Trust.
- 9. Fink filed an Objection to the Markowitz Petition arguing, among other things, that the March 2012 Will did not contain any express language revoking the Black Trust nor did the Will, as a matter of law, revoke the extensive prior estate planning performed by the

Decdendent.

- 10. THE COURT FINDS, that having reviewed the pleadings on file, the March 2012 Will, and having considered the arguments of counsel at hearing, there are a number of reasons that, as a matter of law, the March 2012 Will did not act to revoke the Black Trust.
- THE COURT FURTHER FINDS, that the language of the March 2012 Will does not contain any express language expressly revoking, or even referencing, the Black Trust.

  Therefore, the March 2012 Will is not sufficiently clear to act as a revocation of the Black Trust.
- 12. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that because the Black Trust had been funded by the Decedent there is a clear legal distinction between the assets of the Black Trust and the assets of the estate subject to probate.
- 13. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the language contained in Section 2.1 of the March 2012 will referencing the giving of "my property, both real and personal," references the property of the Decedent, Leroy Black, which is subject to probate and governed by the March 2012 Will, and not the property owned by the Black Trust or any other corporate entity at the time of Decedent's death.
- Total Amendment and Restatement of the Leroy G. Black, 1992 Living Trust, dated October 27, 2009, (The 2009 Restatement) in the event the Decedent had intended to revoke his Trust via the March 2012 Will, he would have also been required to deliver the revoked portion of the Trust property to the Trustor. In other words the property would have been removed from the Black Trust and put back in Decedent's personal name, subjecting the property to probate and distribution in accordance with the March 2012Will. This did not occur as the Black Trust remained funded until decedent's death.

15. THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that, in accordance with section 8.2 of the 200
Restatement, the Black Trust became irrevocable upon the death of the Decedent. Since the
March 2012 Will was not effective until death, that instrument could not validly revoke the
Trust. Restatement: Trusts, sec. 330 comment j, "if the settlor reserves a power to revoke the
trust by a transaction inter vivos, as for example, by a notice to the trustee, he cannot revoke the
trust by his will."

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that Philip Markowitz's Petition to Declare

Revocation of Trust Agreement is hereby denied for the reasons set forth hereinabove.

- OBJECTION: BY EXECUTOR PHILLIP MARKOWITZ TO REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF APRIL 11, 2013 was argued by Counsel. Mr. Barlow stated the executor objected to the Commissioner's finding that the failure of objector to file a contest to the will and a citation within the 90 days granted per statute was not a clear error of law.
