ORDER GRANTING MOTION IN PART

On April 15, 2015, this court entered an order directing appellant to file and serve the opening brief and appendix within 11 days. Appellant failed to file the required documents or otherwise communicate with this court within that time frame. On May 19, 2015, appellant filed an untimely motion for an extension of time to file the opening brief. See NRAP 31(b)(3). Respondent opposes the motion.

Although appellant's counsel has repeatedly failed to comply with this court's rules and directives we, nevertheless, agree that a short extension is warranted. Appellant shall have 11 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Respondent shall have 30 days from the service of the opening brief and appendix to file the answering brief. Appellant shall have 10 days from service of the answering brief to file any reply brief.

Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal.
