This is an appeal from a district court order denying a motion to modify child custody and support. Marshal S. Willick, Esq. of Willick Law Group has filed a motion for leave to file an amicus brief outside the time provided in NRAP 29(f). Under NRAP 29(f), a motion for leave to file an amicus curiae brief must be filed no later than seven days after the brief of the party being supported is filed, or if neither party is being supported, seven days after the opening brief is filed. Here, Willick's motion was untimely filed seven days after oral argument was held and the case submitted for decision. Under these circumstances, the motion is denied. The clerk of this court is directed to return, unfiled, Willick's proposed amicus curiae brief provisionally received on February 17, 2016.

It is so ORDERED.
