I. <u>INTRODUCTION AND FACTUAL SUMMARY</u>

For various reasons, as set forth below, Real Party in Interest, High Noon at Arlington Ranch Homeowners Association ("Real Party in Interest" or "Association") respectfully requests an extension of time to file its Answering Brief to Petitioner, D.R. Horton, Inc.'s ("DRH") Writ Petition. DRH has no objection to the extension set forth below. The rules justify the short extension to ensure the legal issues are adequately addressed.

II. LEGAL ARGUMENT

Nevada Rules of Appellate Procedure, Rule 31(b) (3) states:

Motion for Extension of Time. A motion for extension of time for filing a brief may be made no later than the due date for the brief and must comply with the provisions of this Rule and Rule 27.

- A. Contents of Motion. A motion for extension of time for filing a brief shall include the following:
 - (i) The date when the brief is due;
 - (ii) The number of extensions of time previously granted (including a 5-day telephone extension), and if extensions were granted, the original date when the brief was due:
 - (iii) Whether any previous requests for extension of time have been denied or denied in part;
 - (iv) The reasons or grounds why an extension is necessary; and
 - (v) The length of the extension requested and the date on which the brief would become due.

A. The Date When the Briefs Are Due

The Answering Brief is currently due on October 26, 2014 per Supreme Court Order. Association is requesting an extension of twelve (12) days, up to and including November 7, 2014.

B. The Number of Extensions of Time Previously Granted (Including a 5-Day Telephonic Extension), and if Extensions Were Granted, the Original Date When the Brief Was Due

No request for extension have been made by Petitioner DRH nor the Association.

C. Whether Any Previous Request for Extension of Time Have Been Denied or Denied in Part

There has been no request for an extension of time and therefore no requests for extensions have been denied or denied in part.

D. The Reasons or Ground Why an Extension is Necessary

Several reasons exist that justify good cause. In addition to Petitioner DRH's forty-one (41) page Writ Petition, DRH filed an additional Writ Petition in the same matter just two days after the instant Writ Petition (Case No.66101) requiring significant additional research and response from the Association. The legal issues involved in DRH's Writ, the Answering Brief are complex and of first impression, impacting several currently pending cases in the District Court. Thus, additional time is necessary to sufficiency address the complicated issues which are pertinent
