10 **MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FAST TRACK STATEMENT**

11 Appellant Kirk Harrison hereby moves for a 5-day extension of time for the fast track
12 statement, which is presently due for filing on April 6, 2015. This due date was established in
13 an order filed on March 20, 2015 (which was electronically served on March 23, 2015). The
14 order allowed 15 days for filing of the fast track statement.

15 Appellant is an attorney, and he is also counsel of record in this appeal. He is working
16 very closely with counsel Eisenberg, taking primary responsibility for initial preparation of the
17 fast track statement.

18 Mr. Harrison has a previous commitment in another civil case pending in St. George,
19 Utah, state court on April 7, 2015. The case involves a real property dispute. There are
20 multiple parties, and there are several motions pending for a hearing on April 7, 2015. This
21 hearing was scheduled more than three months ago, and it cannot be rescheduled. Mr. Harrison
22 will need to prepare extensively for the hearing in the days leading up to April 7, and on the day
23 of the hearing he will be traveling to Utah, arguing the motions, and traveling back to Las
24 Vegas.

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1 Under these circumstances, it will be virtually impossible for Mr. Harrison and Mr.
2 Eisenberg to complete the fast track statement by the present due date. Accordingly, appellant
3 hereby requests a 5-day extension until April 13, 2015.¹

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25 ¹ The fast track statement was originally due on March 18, 2015. Appellant moved to
26 remove this case from the fast track program. The motion included a request to suspend the
27 time for the fast track statement, pending the court's ruling on the motion to remove the case
28 from the fast track program. On March 20, 2015, which was two days after the original due
date, the court issued its order denying the motion to remove the case from the fast track
program, and establishing the new 15-day time limit for the fast track statement.
