This due date was established in 13 an order filed on March 20, 2015 (which was electronically served on March 23, 2015). The 14 order allowed 15 days for filing of the fast track statement. 15 Appellant is an attorney, and he is also counsel of record in this appeal. He is working 16 very closely with counsel Eisenberg, taking primary responsibility for initial preparation of the fast track statement. 17 18 Mr. Harrison has a previous commitment in another civil case pending in St. George, 19 Utah, state court on April 7, 2015. The case involves a real property dispute. There are multiple parties, and there are several motions pending for a hearing on April 7, 2015. This 20 hearing was scheduled more than three months ago, and it cannot be rescheduled. Mr. Harrison 21 22 will need to prepare extensively for the hearing in the days leading up to April 7, and on the day 23 of the hearing he will be traveling to Utah, arguing the motions, and traveling back to Las 24 Vegas. 25 /// /// 26 /// 27

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Under these circumstances, it will be virtually impossible for Mr. Harrison and Mr. Eisenberg to complete the fast track statement by the present due date. Accordingly, appellant hereby requests a 5-day extension until April 13, 2015.¹
