

RESPONSE TO ORDER OF SUPREME COURT (Explanation why Nevada Supreme Court Should KEEP the Case)

Respondent DIANE MIZRACHI herein responds to the ORDER of the Nevada Supreme Court filed March 30, 2015, stating why this Nevada Supreme Court should retain this case, as opposed to relinquishing this matter to the newly formed Court of Appeals.
