**ORDER GRANTING MOTION**

This is an appeal from a divorce decree and order changing the child's last name. Respondent has filed a motion to correct the record to include evidence that respondent's name is the same as his father's. Respondent also argues that his last name is not difficult to pronounce. The motion is opposed, and respondent has filed a reply. Having considered the motion and opposition, we grant the motion; however, we caution the parties that in its review of this appeal, this court will not consider evidence not properly submitted to the district court. *Carson Ready Mix v. First Nat'l Bank*, 97 Nev. 474, 476, 635 P.2d 276, 277 (1981).
