POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Nevada Rule of Appellate Procedure 41(b)(3) provides for a stay of the issuance of this Court's remittitur pending filing of a petition for certiorari in the United States Supreme Court. Mr. Moore already requested, and this Court ordered, a stay of the remittitur in this case for 120 days, until August 27, 2018. *See* Order Staying Issuance of Remittitur (May 3, 2018).

On July 17, 2018, the United States Supreme Court granted an extension of time within which Mr. Moore could file his petition for writ of certiorari, up to and including September 24, 2018. Nevada Rule of Appellate Procedure 41(b)(3)(B) allows that a stay of remittitur can "for cause shown" be extended. Cause is present here because this is a death penalty case raising federal constitutional grounds subject to the United States Supreme Court's review. These issues are important. This Court should allow the United States Supreme Court to consider whether they warrant granting a petition for writ of certiorari.

Mr. Moore requests this Court extend the stay of remittitur up to and including September 30, 2018, which will provide enough time for this Court to receive notice "from the clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States" that Mr. Moore has filed his petition.²
