APPELLANTS' EMERGENCY MOTION UNDER NRAP 27(e) FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE APPELLANTS' OPENING BRIEF (THIRD REQUEST)

Pursuant to NRAP 27(e)(2), action on this Motion is necessary on or before Tuesday, May 12, 2015.

Pursuant to NRAP 26(b)(1)(B), 27(e) and 31(b)(3), Appellants request an extension of time of two weeks, up to and including May 27, 2015, in which to file their opening brief. The brief is currently due to be filed on May 13, 2015. This Continuance is necessary because the attorney responsible for drafting the Opening Brief, Melanie Morgan, Esq., tendered her resignation on or about April 10, 2015

and is no longer with Appellants' retained law firm. Ms. Morgan's departure necessitated that the drafting of the opening brief be reassigned to Tyler J. Watson, Esq. The Respondent stipulates to this request.

The Opening Brief was originally due on March 13, 2015, but the Court granted the Parties' stipulation to continue the matter to April 13, 2015. Then the Court granted a second extension to May 13, 2015. Thereafter, the Parties stipulated to continue the Opening Brief due date to May 27, but the Stipulation was denied on May 8, 2015 because the Stipulation did not contain an explanation of the "extreme and unforeseeable circumstance" which would allow for a third continuance.

Here, the extreme and unforeseeable circumstance necessitating a continuance is Ms. Morgan's unexpected departure from Appellants' retained law firm. It is a time-consuming task for a new attorney to learn the facts and history of this case, which consist of three prior mediations, two petitions for judicial review, a two day evidentiary hearing and a judicial foreclosure. Accordingly, Appellants and Respondent requests an extension as detailed above.
