Bennight, 91 Nev. 763, 766, 542 P.2d 1400, 1403 (1975) (taking judicial notice of the public records of the Nevada Real Estate Division indicating that Edward Jory "was the officer licensed as broker on behalf of the corporation"); see also Chas. L. Harney, Inc. v. State, 31 Cal. Rptr. 524, 529 (Ct. App. 1963) (taking judicial notice of the "official records and files of the State Board of Control and of the office of the State Controller").
