

## ORDER

When this matter was docketed, appellant was proceeding in proper person. The Washoe County Alternate Public Defender has now filed a request for clarification regarding representation informing this court that the district court appointed counsel for appellant for purposes of pursuing this appeal when appellant filed the notice of appeal.

Cause appearing, we conclude that all parties are now represented by counsel,<sup>1</sup> and we remove this appeal from the pilot program for processing proper person civil appeals. Counsel shall have 15 days from the date of this order to file and serve the transcript request form. See NRAP 9(a).<sup>2</sup> Counsel shall have 90 days from the date of this
